



# <u>Approved Certifier of Construction Scheme:</u> (Drainage, Plumbing & Heating)

The Scheme, which was approved by the Scottish Government, allows ACCS businesses to self-certify work carried out under a Building Warrant. This "self-certification" is an alternate to using local authority building standards inspectors.

The Approved Certifier of Construction Scheme covers drainage, heating and plumbing work (including all micro-renewables). Members of the Scheme are able to issue certificates on completion of work which **MUST be accepted** by local authorities.

## The work covered by the scheme includes:

- Above & below ground drainage
- Unvented systems
- Gas appliances (above and below 70kw)
- Solid fuel appliances
- Oil appliances
- Solar thermal panels and heat pumps
- Oil tanks

## Joining the Scheme:

To become a Certifier of the Scheme the operative must attend and successfully pass a one day Building Standards Training Course. The Approved Certifier must also be qualified to at least **Advanced** or **Technical** craftsman level and hold appropriate qualifications for the scope of work which they wish to self-certify. They must also hold a **Water Byelaws/Regulations** qualification.

To join the Approved Certifier of Construction Scheme, individuals (Approved Certifiers) must be employed by a business (Approved Body) who is a member of the Plumbing Industry Licensing Scheme (which is operated by SNIPEF) or who meets the Licensing Scheme criteria.

#### There are many benefits in operating the scheme:

- · Your client will pay a reduced building warrant fee if they advise the Local Authority that they are using an Approved Certifier of Construction.
- · You will be able to "Self-Certify" (as long as you have demonstrated your technical competency) above or below ground drainage, heating installations (gas, oil, solid fuel boilers), unvented systems, microrenewables (Biomass, solar and heat pumps) and electrical work associated with any of these installations, which is subject to a building warrant.
- Local Authority Building Control Departments (now known as Verifiers) cannot refuse to accept an Approved Certifier certificate nor can they ask to inspect work which has been certified by an Approved Certifier. You will be able to use a logo which will contain the Scottish Government logo and which will indicate that you are a Scottish Government "Approved" contractor.
