HOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMMES FOR SCOTLAND (HEEPS)

The Scottish Government has now opened a new HEEPS Cashback Vouchers Scheme and a HEEPS Loans Scheme which will offer homeowners interest-free loans for energy efficiency measures. Through the Cashback Scheme, the Scottish Government is offering owner occupiers, private and social tenants and registered private sector landlords a rebate of up to £500 towards installing a new boiler for properties that are in council tax bands A to C.

Through the Loans Scheme, the Government is making available interest free, unsecured loans of up to £4,000 to householders for installing a new boiler, cylinder thermostat and hot water cylinder. All installations must be recommended by an energy advice report, and households in remote areas will be entitled to greater amounts to cover the increased costs they face.

LEADING CONSTRUCTION BODY URGES POLITICAL PARTIES TO DO MORE FOR CONSTRUCTION SMEs

Ahead of the General Election, the Specialist Engineering Contractors' (SEC) Group has published its Construction Manifesto. The SEC Group, of which SNIPEF is a part, represents the largest sector in UK construction by value. By publishing this manifesto the SEC Group invites all parties to give greater priority to the concerns of SMEs in construction.

The Manifesto lists the following seven priorities to be addressed by the next government.

- Improvement of cash flow through the wider use of project bank accounts and legislation to protect cash retentions;
- Standardisation of the pre-qualification process;
- Development of programmes of work directed at improving carbon efficiency in existing building stock through the use of incentives;
- A target of 3 years to return to pre-recession training levels for engineering apprentices;
- Reduction of wasteful activity and poor practices through radically changing public sector procurement by appointing the supply chain earlier and insuring an agreed cost plan;
- Introduction of legislation to establish the role of an adjudicator or ombudsman to promote good practice in public sector procurement; and
- Introduction of rigorous requirements relating to the health and safety competence of all firms before they carry out any construction activity.

REVIEW OF THE NATIONAL OCCUPATIONAL STANDARDS

Following SummitSkills' review of the National Occupational Standards and re-accreditation of the Plumbing SVQ Level 3, the plumbing industry (SNIPEF) seeks the views of employers on the suitability of the modern apprenticeship (MA) for Plumbing and Heating. The MA is designed to provide apprentices with the opportunity to develop the necessary competencies required to carry out the role of a competent plumber and form part of the 4-year plumbing apprenticeship.
